

2018 PKU-UTokyo Nano-carbon Summer Camp

- Call for Participation - **Place**: Peking University, Beijing, China **Time**: Aug. 4-11, 2018

General information:

Following the big success of three previous camps (July 2015 at Tokyo, July 2016 at Beijing, July 2017 at Tokyo), the 2018 PKU-UTokyo Nano-carbon summer camp will be held in Peking University, Beijing, China, during Aug. 4-11, 2018. This camp will bring together more than 20 students and 10 faculty members from two sides. In a week time, participants will intensively discuss cutting edge progresses in nano-carbon & low-dimensional material research and propose potential collaborations between PKU and UTokyo.

Expected participants:

Mater or Doctoral regular course Japanese and International students who are working or interested in nano-carbon & low-dimensional material research. Max. 10 students will be accepted this year.

Expense:

The travel expenses of faculty at UTokyo will be covered by Top Global University Project of UTokyo. The travel expenses of students will be covered by UTokyo (flight) and PKU (living expenses).

Tentative camp activities:

- > Aug. 4: Flight from Tokyo to Beijing, Aug. 11: Flight from Beijing to Tokyo.
- > Workshop and lectures on nano-carbon research
- > Group discussion and presentation of proposed collaborative research
- ▶ Lab, campus, and city tour, and etc.
